

Regulations of the Royal Thai Police  
on code of police regulations unrelated to case  
Category 34  
Immigration  
(Volume 6)  
B.E.2563 (2020)

It is deemed expedient to amend the code of police regulations unrelated to case, category 34 Immigration, chapter 6 Inspection of persons and conveyances in order to improve the pattern of immigration stamps for inspecting persons entering into or departing the Kingdom to be up-to-date and difficult to counterfeit;

By virtue of section 11 of the Royal Thai Police Act B.E.2547 (2004) and its amendments, Commissioner General of the Royal Thai Police hereby issues the following regulations:

1. The article 10 of section 1, chapter 6 regarding the Inspection of persons and conveyances of category 34 Immigration of the code of police regulations unrelated to case as amended by the regulations of the Royal Thai Police on code of police regulations unrelated to case, category 34 Immigration (volume 5) B.E.2562 (2019) as amended by the order no.249/2562 dated April 19, 2019 issued by the Royal Thai Police regarding the use of immigration stamps for granting permission to enter into and depart the Kingdom shall be repealed and superseded by the article attached to this regulation.

2. This regulation shall come into force after one hundred and twenty days from the date of its publication.

10. Inspection of various types of passengers entering into and departing the Kingdom, a competent official shall inspect and permit by stamping an immigration stamp or attaching an immigration sticker which has the following characteristics:

10.1 Immigration stamps for passport control (Rubber stamp)

10.1.1 The arrival stamp's characteristics are as follows;



(1) Its shape is like a national flag, 4.2 centimeters in length, 2.7 centimeters in height.

(2) On the left, row 1 contains uppercase English letters "IMMIGRATION THAILAND" to indicate that it is a stamp of Thailand.

(3) On the left, row 2 contains uppercase English letters indicating a name of immigration checkpoint to inform where to enter into the Kingdom.

(4) Inside the top and bottom parts of stamp border contain a stamp code. The code starts with an uppercase English letter and followed by Arabic numbers. The specified letters categorize the permitted travelling channels of immigration checkpoints: "L" is by land, "A" is by air and "W" is by sea.

(5) Inside the stamp contains uppercase English letters "VISACLASS" for a competent immigration official who inspects to indicate a visa type of alien entering into the Kingdom.

(6) There are uppercase English letters "ADMITTED" aligned to the left border indicating an entry to Kingdom.

(7) Next to (6), indicating an arrival date and year in Arabic numbers and an abbreviation of arrival month in uppercase English letters with 2.5 centimeters in length, 0.4 centimeters in height

(8) There are uppercase English letters "UNTIL" next to (7) indicating a due date on which a competent official allows an alien to stay in the Kingdom.

(9) There are uppercase English letters "SIGNED" next to (8) presenting a signature of competent official who inspects.

10.1.2 The departure stamp has its characteristics as follows;



(1) It is a horizontal oval and its shape is like a Thai rice seed. The diameter is 4.5 centimetres in length and 3 centimetres in height.

(2) The oval border is a solid line.

(3) Inside the oval, there are uppercase English letters "IMMIGRATION THAILAND" on the top and a name of immigration checkpoint where to depart the Kingdom in uppercase English letters on the bottom.

(4) The next row is a stamp code which starts with an uppercase English letter and then followed by Arabic numbers. The specified letters categorize the permitted travelling channels of immigration checkpoints: "L" is by land, "A" is by air and "W" is by sea.

(5) There are uppercase English letters "DEPARTED" inside the oval, indicating a departure from the Kingdom.

(6) Next to (5) indicating a departure date and year in Arabic numbers and an abbreviation of departure month in uppercase English letter with 2.5 centimetres in length and 0.4 centimetres in height

(7) There are uppercase English letters "SIGNED" next to (6) presenting a signature of competent official who inspects.



## 10.2 Immigration stamps for passport control (Sticker)

10.2.1 The arrival sticker is in rectangle shape with 4 centimetres in width, 5 centimetres in length. There are a Garuda emblem and Thai letters “สำนักงานตรวจคนเข้าเมือง” and “IMMIGRATION BUREAU” in English on the top. The sticker contains information of entry date, expiry date, visa type and permission period by the following example;



10.2.2 The departure sticker is in rectangle shape with 4 centimetres in width, 5 centimetres in length. There are a Garuda emblem and Thai letters “สำนักงานตรวจคนเข้าเมือง” and “IMMIGRATION BUREAU” in English on the top. The sticker contains information of departure date, expiry date, visa type and permission period by the following example;
